## WATER LEAK!!

The Missouri Water Association, which manages our water supply, has informed us that there is a leak in our system somewhere. They have been monitoring the total gallons pumped through our well and can tell that in the months of December through February the usage is considerably above the average usage for that time. They believe that the leak is probably in a line leading off of the main line into one of the homes. They ask that if anyone should see any abnormal amount of water surfacing to please contact them at 573-346-3810 or after hours at 866-504-1646.
